Royal Reesink N.V. sees the environmental and energy policy as well as concern for safety, health and welfare - as an integral part of the overall business, which is aimed at continuous improvement of the environmental and energy performance. Royal Reesink N.V. and its subsidiaries will do what is possible to reduce or avoid the environmental effects as far as possible.

Laws and regulations

The Environmental Management Act (milieuvergunning) and Activities Decree (activiteitenbesluit) include general requirements in Art. 2.1 duty of care (zorgplicht) and Section 2.6 energy saving (energiebesparing), the Vlarem and European Energy Directive (EED) are the current main legislative arrangements to meet. Responsibilities and tasks are defined and activities agreed to demonstrate that compliance with the applicable laws and regulations.

Royal Reesink N.V. and its subsidiaries do however, where possible, more than is required by law if the effort is in healthy relationship to the result. Thereby priority will be given to environmental and energy policies which also have a positive impact in areas such as safety, health , welfare, quality and efficiency.

Reducing the environmental impact

All operations of Royal Reesink N.V. and its subsidiaries have an effect on the environment. These effects are sought to minimize the taking of preventive or restrictive measures , both organizational and technical.

Royal Reesink N.V. and its subsidiaries endeavour:

To make responsible use of the required raw materials and auxiliary materials.

Where necessary opt for other materials whose properties or production methods are more environmentally friendly.
